### PURPOSE

To clarify the terms and definitions used in the QMS and the new ISO 9001 standard

### SCOPE

These definitions apply to all elements of the standard and of the QMS

Organization: Georgia Gulf Sulfur Corporation, including Georgia Gulf Sulfur, Holly Industries, International Sulphur, Inc., and S.F. Sulfur  
QMS: Quality Management System

### RESPONSIBILITY

All responsibilities related to this element are found in the Procedure section of this document

### PROCEDURE

The Organization has been previously registered to ISO 9001:1994. In the new standard, the term "Organization" replaces the term "Supplier" and the term "Supplier" replaces the term "Subcontractor".

The following terms, used in ISO 9001 to describe the supply chain, have been revised to clarify the description of all of the following functions:

**Supplier → Organization → Customer**

As the new standard is generic in content, the word "Product" can also be used to mean "Service".
